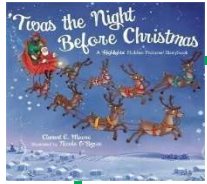
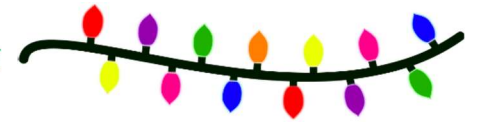


LAST WEEK OF TERM – CHRISTMAS ACTIVITIES TO DO AT HOME

For example: shape, size, colour, the amount, where they are in relation to each other (e.g. above, below, in-between).

Using tinsel (or any other material) make as many different shapes as you can, Then name and describe them.



Practise traditional and modern Christmas songs e.g. Jingle Bells, Away in a Manger, Rudolph the Red Nosed Reindeer, 12 days of Christmas, etc.

Watch and discuss The First Christmas Story.

Make your own bauble for the tree using paper, card, pens, paint, sequins, glitter, and stickers.
Be as creative as you can!
